**GREAT NEWS!** Hunting in Nepal resumed in 2008 after a 5-year hiatus. We are hunting the old reliable areas where superb trophies were regularly taken. Some of these areas have not been hunted for 10 years or more.

We have conducted hunts in this amazing country over 40 years. To many hunters, Nepal offers the finest mountain hunting experience in the world.

Nepal is one of the richest countries in the world in terms of bio-diversity due to its unique geographical location and variation in altitude. The elevation of the country ranges from sea level to the highest point on earth, Mt. Everest, at 29,029 feet. All of this variation is within a distance of less than 100 miles, resulting in climate conditions from sub-tropical to extreme cold. The breath-taking Himalayas of Nepal awaits you.



**Seasons:** March & April; October & November

**Altitudes:** Our spring hunts will be approximately 9,000 feet at base camp with hunting up to 11,000 - 12,000 feet. Fall hunts will be at 11,000 feet with hunting up to 12,000 - 14,000 feet.

**Hunts:** 13 or 14-Day Himalayan Blue Sheep Schedule  
Single hunter (1x1)  
Two hunters or more (each)  
(Surcharge of \$100 per inch on horns over 25 inches)

16-17-Day Himalayan Blue Sheep & Tahr Schedule

(Surcharge of \$100 per inch on horns over 25 inches)

13-14-Day Himalayan Tahr Hunt Schedule  
Single hunter (1X1)

**Additional Species:** Barking Deer (Muntjac) and Wild Boar can also be hunted, if available in your hunting area. Serow and Ghoral may also be in your area but they are on Appendix I of CITES and cannot be hunted.



**Licenses:** Licenses, permits and community fees are extra.

**Transport:** Chopper fees are extra and the price depends on the number of hunters in your group. Small choppers are utilized and weight restrictions apply. Small choppers will accommodate two persons + the pilot. If there are more than 2 persons, additional small choppers are utilized.

**Trekking:** It is possible to trek into the area in the spring. A 4-wheel vehicle will take you from Kathmandu to Darbang. You will overnight in Darbang and begin your trek to base camp. Depending on your condition, it will take 4-5 days to make it to base camp. The price, including all transportation and permits.

**Non-Hunters:** There is an additional charge for non-hunters.
