KORYAK SNOW SHEEP

(Ovis nivicola koriakorum)

Sheep hunts are based from remote camps in the Vetveyskiy Mountains. Elevations of these mountains are relatively low, reaching only about 5000 feet.

The terrain consists of mostly low, rolling type country. All hunting is done on foot from basic, but comfortable tent camps. Rams in this area will be in the 35-38" class. Hunts take place in August and early September.

You will fly RT air Moscow/Petrovlovsk, RT air Petrovlovsk/Tilichiki and VIP reception in Petrovlovsk.

The total price for an air charter is based on the number on board.



SCHEDULE

This hunt is based on a 19-day schedule from the U.S., with 9 to 10 full hunting days.

- Day - 1 Depart U.S.
- Day - 2 Arrive Moscow/overnight
- Day - 3 Depart Moscow (evening departure)
- Day - 4 Arrive Petrovlovsk AM. If commercial airline schedules jive, you will fly commercially from Petrovlovsk to Tilichiki.
- Day - 5 Air charter to hunting area
- Day - 6 to 10-day Koryak Sheep Hunt
- Day - 15
- Day - 16 Air Charter return to Tilichiki/overnight
- Day - 17 Return to Petrovlovsk
- Day - 18 Fly commercially back to Moscow/overnight
- Day - 19 Return home.

**Due to limited internal flights, hunt days may be shortened to 8 days.*



GIANT KORYAK MOOSE *(Alces alces buturlini)*

Our moose hunts are conducted in the lower valleys, along the rivers, streams and lakes that are scattered throughout this region. All hunting will be done on foot and possibly with the use of boats or rafts from tented camps. This country is similar to that found on the Alaska Peninsula. Bull moose in this area have been taken up to 73+". A realistic expectation for most hunters to be in the 58-63" class. Hunting is done in late September and early October during the rut.

(Helicopters will be used to access the camps only. There will be **NO HUNTING done from the helicopter on the same day of flight).*
