Hunts are 15 days and include Lesser Kudu, Southern Gerenuk, Northern Grant's Gazelle, Beisa Oryx, Guenther's DikDik, Tiang, Abyssinian Bushbuck, Golden & Silverback Jackel, Spotted Hyena, East African Bush Duiker, Klipspringer, Crocodile and Serval.

Includes all OMO species plus: Nile Buffalo, Neumann Hartebeest, Abyssinian Greater Kudu, Defassa Waterbuck, Caracal & Oribi. Special arrangements can be made for lion. Hunts are 21-day. Plan this hunt well in advance as Nile Buffalo permits are very limited.

MOUNTAIN NYALA

The magnificent Mountain Nyala is native only to Ethiopia. It is a very shy and wary animal, which makes the best use of the mountainous terrain, which it calls home. Hunt the low land foothills from 6000-7500 feet, year round from the Domaro camp. The high mountain hunts are conducted from the OdoBulo camp at elevations between 7500-11,000 feet from November through May. A new permanent base camp helps lessen the rigors of the hunt in between forays to the far reaches of



the area. Moveable-tented fly camps are as comfortable as conditions permit and horses are used to cover the long distances involved. No effort is spared to place you in the areas where we feel you have the best chance of bagging Africa's finest trophy.

Hunts are 21-days and you can also add Melelik's Bushbuck and in limited areas, Klipspringer, Abyssinian Bohor Reedbuck, East African Bush Duiker, Spotted Hyena and Giant Forest Hog. Many of our hunters describe this hunt as the ulti-

mate – both from a standpoint of challenging terrain to being with amazing professionals. You will truly challenge yourself and will want to return.

OMO VALLEY SAFARI

The Omo Valley supports one of Africa's largest and most unique game populations which include several endemic as well as other species that can be hunted nowhere else. Each year produces new record trophies and there are still areas remaining to be explored.
