

Limpopo

We hunt on excellent concessions in Limpopo. The camps are approximately a three and a half hour drive north of Johannesburg. Most of the areas in Limpopo that we hunt are very mountainous with scattered open plains within these mountains. Many of the common plains game animals can be found in these areas but the main attractions are: big Kudu, Southern Impala, Warthog, Klipspringer, Waterbuck and we have limited permits for Roan and Sable. Buffalo permits are becoming more plentiful - for those interested in hunting a buffalo, this is a very exciting hunt. Please contact us early so we can make sure to get a permit. The accommodation varies from very comfortable permanent structures to tented camps.

The Eastern Cape

consists of coastal forests to semi desert plains to mountain ranges where the elusive Vaal Rhebuck and Cape Grysbok await. Other unique trophies include Red Lechwe, Blue Duiker, Fallow Deer and over 20 species of plains game. Traveling is required in order to hunt a full range of game. Weather changes can be quite rapid due to the diversity in habitats and a full range of clothing is prudent. There are daily flights to Port Elizabeth and East London where you will be met by your Professional Hunter.

The area known as Zululand lies 3 hours north of Durbin along the spectacular Natal coastline. Zululand is thick with ancient culture and is a good destination combining a family vacation with a hunting safari. The area is home to a menagerie of species including Nyala, Zebra, Kudu, White Rhino, Blue Wildebeest, Grey Duiker, Impala, Bushbuck, Warthog and Bushpig to name but a few and is prolific with bird life. The rarer, smaller game such as Red Duiker, Oribi and Livingston Suni are the main attraction.
