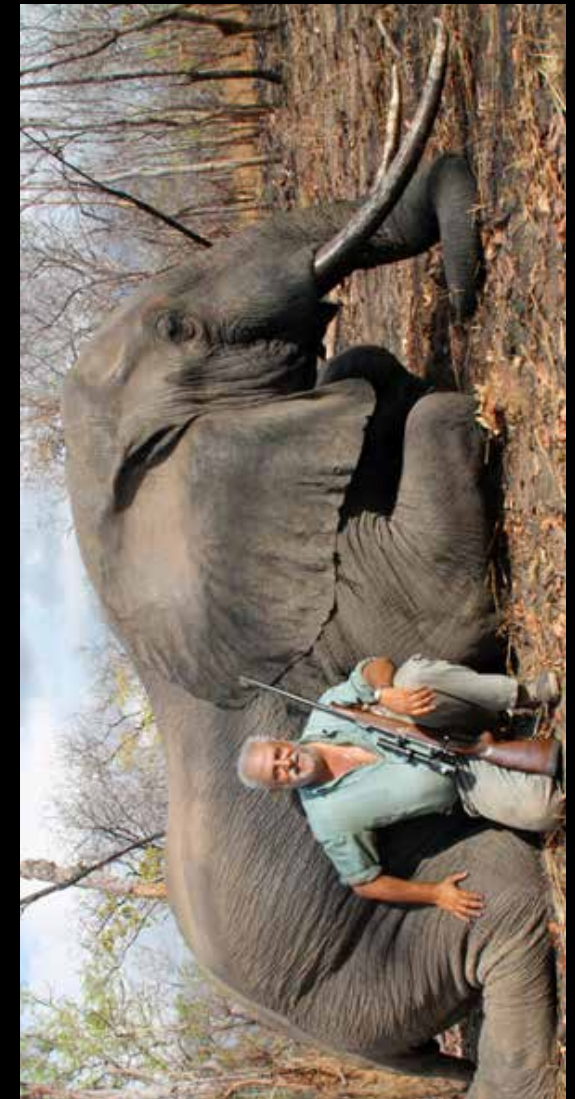

Tanzania has some of the finest hunting grounds on the African continent, where large concentrations of game can still be found. Due to the Tanzania Government's wise policy towards its wildlife heritage, vast portions of the country have been set aside for Game Preserves, Controlled Hunting Areas and National Parks.

The Selous Game Reserve is the last wild paradise! Declared a National Park in 1905, the Reserve encompasses over 31,000 square miles of prime habitat totally uninhabited by man. A unique and beautiful natural setting with every type of topography, the Park is home to more than a million animals representing all the most important species to be found in Africa. The visitor to the Selous Game Reserve today sees Africa in the same state that enchanted famous names of the past such as Karen Blixen and Ernest Hemingway.

The vegetation is mainly 'miombo' bush with dense thickets in some areas. Some of the largest rivers in Tanzania flow through the Selous. Game that can be taken in the Reserve includes elephant, lion, leopard, buffalo, wildebeest, hartebeest, impala, warthog, eland, sable and greater kudu.

Masailand, located in Northern Tanzania is well known for exceptional buffalo, huge leopard, very big greater kudu and unique species such as lesser kudu, gerenuk and oryx. Beautiful camps are set in the Masai steppes and offer the same amenities as the Selous mainly acacia country with thorn tickets and great open plains. July thru mid Oct. is good hunting weather.
